### BECOMING BOND

A new gallery hits the New York scene tonight with some of the best young art around



Five years ago, the downtown gallery scene exploded with a slew of new art purveyors. They've firmly established ground—their artists now have shows at the Whitney and leading museums around the world—and once again centered the spotlight on New York art. Now it's time for some fresh blood. A new generation comes to the fore with the opening of 33 Bond tonight in the East Village. As its debut exhibition, the gallery unveils "I LOVE NEW YORK," a group show of the nine young artists currently under its wing. Co-directors Alix Frey and Rebecca Mirsky spent six months searching for the latest in up and coming art. Now they present this survey of the best young artists coming out of the five boroughs, shown together for the first time. It's proof that the next generation of New York artists is not only alive and well—it also exercises its right to organize.
