Profile

Never let it be said that artists don't suffer God complexes. In 'Apollo and Daphne' Korean artist Seunghyo Jang seems to have taken that sentiment to heart – his futuristic, vaguely *Blade Runner*-ish sculptures of the Greek God and his lover are meant to be representations of Jang and his girlfriend. Crafted out of photographs of assorted urban icons (the Chrysler building! Empire State!) and junk (headlights, tires.), the works themselves are masterfully detailed. Sadly, what's on display are photographs of the works, so the effect – presumably of artist as God – falls woefully flat. — Tara Kilachand
